- Speedball nibs C2 and C3 (in perfect shape!)
- Black non-waterproof ink; Pelican, Waterman, Parker, Higgins, Noodler, Sumi... anything goes, except Winsor and Newton ink.
- White paper A3 size; layout paper and/or Canson croquis sketch paper are fine, but plain printing paper is equally fine as long as the ink doesn't bleed. Make sure the paper is transparent enough, as you want to see the guidelines through it.
