- Calligraphy quality paper (i.e. Canson Marker Paper, HP Premium 32, Strathmore 25% or 100%, John Neal Bookseller practice paper, Rhodia, Staples paper 73333)
- Your favorite pointed pen nib and holder (straight or oblique)
- Ink (recommended: walnut, sumi, iron gall, or gouache)
- Printer (for provided guidesheets & handouts)
- Internet connection!
- A quiet space to focus

You may also choose to participate with pencil or a brush pen!

You can be a beginner at Copperplate but you need to be comfortable using a dip pen. All skill levels are welcome but we won't be covering the basics of using a nib. (You could use a pencil or a brush pen!)
