



CELTIC KNOTWORK with Joy Daniels

Join us and learn how to unravel the intricacies of the Celtic Knot and design your own knotwork patterns. With a few simple rules and a square grid you will discover how to construct the simplest knot and then build on this to make your own designs. In the second class I will be explaining the different methods to construct circular and triangular knots. Use these patterns with calligraphy, stone carving, lino cuts, stencils, embroidery, knitting etc, or just on their own as beautiful things.

Supply List:

VERY few supplies are needed for this class. They are as follows:

- Layout paper (or any thin paper you can see through) HB pencil plus a few softer B pencils
- Some coloured pencils
- Eraser
- Black fineliner
- Pencil sharpener
- A compass for drawing circles
- protractor
- ruler

Optional:

Coloured felt pens if you have any already

You may find a lightbox useful for tracing designs on to thicker paper after the class
